MINUTES- REGULAR BOARD MEETING Board of Education

Monday, January 3, 2022

5:30 PM - School Theater

1. The meeting was called to order in the theater at 5:30 by Dave Visser along with a reminder that *"The purpose of our meeting is to increase opportunities and success for every child every day."*
2. Roll Call. Members present at roll call: Ann Mas (virtually), Jaclyn Murphy, Brenda Riemer, and Dave Visser
3. Superintendent Hubbard verified the posting of the meeting notice on December 30th, 2021.
4. Motion by Jaclyn Murphy and second by Ann Mas to approve an amended agenda moving the "Discussion and decision: Appointment of eligible candidates for the Board vacancy" to before going into closed session. Motion carried
5. Informational: Board candidates each had the opportunity to answer each of the following questions:
 - a. What are your reasons you want to serve on the Elcho School District Board of Education?
 - b. Share any background qualifications and experience relevant to the position.
 - c. What is your educational philosophy?
 - d. What are your general views regarding the role of the board and the role of the district administrator?
 - e. What are your general views on the district's strengths and areas that may need improvement?
 - f. What is your availability for board duties?
6. Candidates were able to ask the Board and Administration questions.
7. A paper vote of Board Members present determined that Christine Giles will be appointed to the school Board.
8. Motion by Jaclyn Murphy and seconded by Brenda Riemer to adjourn to closed session. Roll call vote: Mas- Aye, Murphy- Aye, Riemer-Aye, Visser- Aye. Motion carried.
9. When returned from closed session, Brenda Riemer made a motion which was seconded by Jaclyn Murphy for administration to draft the verbage for a referendum for \$1,000,000 over the revenue limit each year for the next three years. Motion carried.
10. Jaclyn Murphy made a motion, which was seconded by Brenda Riemer to adjourn the meeting at 7:02. Motion carried.
