10. Dr. Wetzel and Amy Vickers presented regarding the bike path that the Elcho Area Health Planning, Inc. is in the process of developing from Co. Hwy. B south

They requested an easement which would include maintenance and improvements for that segment of the trail that would go through the Elcho School property south of Elcho to the east of the old railroad grade to link up with Co.
