


Step One: Sign into Google Account





First, click on the plus in the upper left corner. Otherwise, you will be changing other students' work. This will open a new slide for you to add information.

## Step Four: Add Pictures About Your Activity






Look at the arrow above in the picture. Type any words related to your activity into this box. Click return or enter on your keyboard after you type in your words.

Some pictures might be very large and fill the screen. Click and drag the bottom blue corner of the picture to make it smaller.




After you make the picture the size you want, you can move the picture to where you want on the screen. To do this, click and drag on the center of the picture.
