

School Closing Information

Student safety is one of our highest priorities. With the winter season upon us, we will make every effort to keep your child safe and minimize lost instruction time. When making the decision to close school for inclement weather, the district administrator receives information from several different sources, including the Langlade County Highway Department, Lamers Bus Company, Town of Elcho, Elcho School Maintenance Director, and Great Lakes Weather Service. The school district is a large geographic area of several hundred square miles and there can be considerable differences in weather conditions throughout the district. We will do our best to make the appropriate decision in a timely manner, and if possible, by 6:00 a.m. If parents have any doubts or concerns about the weather, they can choose to keep their child(ren) home.
